

Calling all St. Thomas More parishioners!

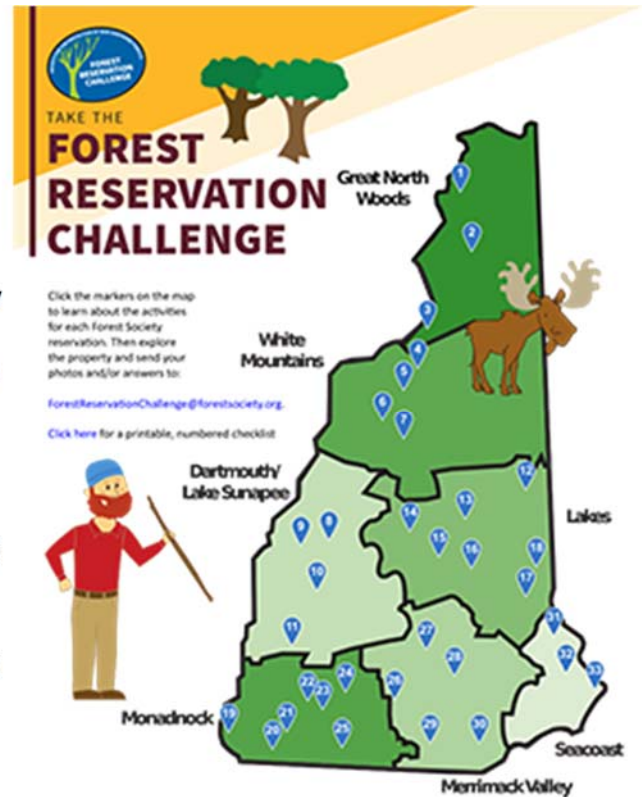

What is the **Forest Reservation Challenge**?

Sponsored by the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests, the **Forest Reservation Challenge** invites us to visit 33 Forest Reservation sites scattered around our beautiful state. This challenge is for all ages!



Once all 33 sites have had a STM visit (by any STM person or family), each participant will be awarded an embroidered Forest Reservation patch and a colored decal!



How do we get started?

Visit the **Forest Reservation Challenge** website <https://forestsociety.org/challenge> for an interactive map of New Hampshire. Each reservation site has a pin. Click on a pin to access information about the site including property details, trail information, directions, and nearby attractions. Then plan your trip!

When should we go? Anytime between May 1 and November 1, 2018.

How do we document our trip? The **Forest Reservation Challenge** website <https://forestsociety.org/challenge> has instructions for taking a site photo and where to email it (Subject line: "Forest Site XXX – Team St. Thomas More"). Photos will not be shared - if the Forest Society wishes to publish photos in their magazine or on their Facebook page, they must first obtain permission. Once a site has been visited by a STM parishioner or family, the site will be starred on our **Forest Reservation Challenge** posters on display in the rear of the church and the Student Center.
