Communication: The HSYM youth minister and other team members communicate with HSYM teen members verbally during sessions, in the weekly church bulletin, by email, text and Facebook. The Facebook page is closed, private and administered by the HSYM youth minister. Email is the primary method of communication with parents. If you have concerns with these methods of communication or do not allow your child to use social media, please notify the HSYM youth minister. While all information is sent to parents, it is the expectation of this program that teens take responsibility for their faith formation and manage the information and their level of participation by communicating directly with the youth minister and other adult leaders.

Volunteering: While teens are expected to participate in service opportunities, this is a volunteer program which only exists by the volunteer work of the adult team members. We ask that, as parents, you consider and volunteer when asked and offer your time and talents to support the HSYM program and your teen's continued Faith Formation. Please contact the HS youth minister in you are willing to volunteer.

Whole Parish Faith Formation and Parish Faith Formation activities will take place during the year. These activities are provided for all and we welcome and encourage the teens to participate with their families.
