Trinity Sunday

The Christian mystery of the Holy Trinity is beautifully expressed in the opening prayer of today's Mass:

"Father, You sent your Son to bring us truth and your Spirit to make us holy. Through them we come to know the mystery of your life. Help us to worship you, one God in three Persons, by proclaiming and living our faith in you."

From the very earliest times, the public prayer of the Church has addressed God as Father, Son and Spirit. This lived experience helped the Church to understand its own faith even before this faith was expressed in the form of doctrine.

This short phrase is a proclamation of one of the central teachings of the Christian faith. With this proclamation we profess what Jesus has revealed of God's identity. It is Christianity's answer to the question: Who is God?

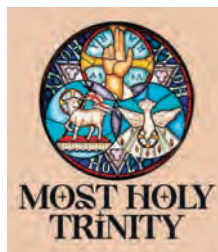
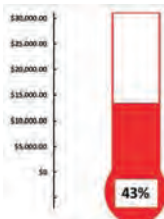

New Keyboard for Our Music Ministry!

Our current keyboard has been in a continuing decline in terms of the functioning of keys and pedals and we very much appreciate the importance of music in our worship services. The Parish Finance Council is planning to replace the current keyboard with a new one. The new one we have selected is the newest version of this same make and model as the current keyboard and has been recommended by the Music Ministry. The total cost of the new keyboard package is **approximately \$2,500**. Already, a few Parishioners have expressed an interest in donating toward this acquisition to help defray the cost. 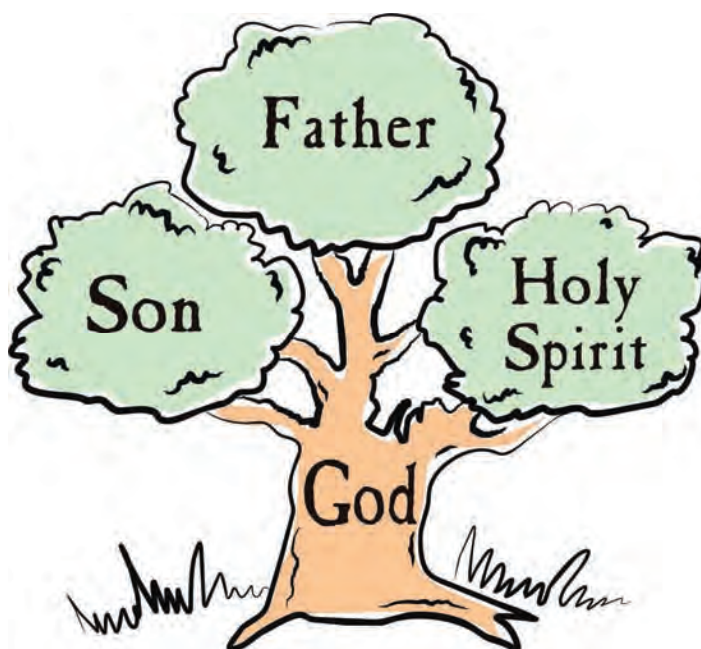
